

Excursion on April 6th.

Visit to Park Hoge Veluwe, one of the Netherlands' oldest and largest National Park.

De Hoge Veluwe National Park is the largest actively managed conservation area in private hands in the Netherlands. The Park covers 5,400 hectares of woodland, heathland, peat bogs and drift sand. It enjoys a wide variety of plants and animals and provides habitats to extremely rare Red List species.

Together with the Kröller-Müller Museum with its worldfamous collection of paintings (Picasso, van Gogh, Seurat, Mondriaan etc.), the Sculpture Garden and Country-residence/Museum Jachthuis Sint Hubertus, the Park forms a unique and (inter)nationally renowned combination of nature, art and architecture.

Programme

The excursion programme is scheduled as below including guided (English spoken) tours but ofcourse you are free to visit the park and musea on your own. We will provide brochure including maps. Forms will be handed out at the registration desk on the first conference day. This to let us know if you prefer to join guided tours or not. The museum Kröller-Muller, the visitors centre and the Museonder are only 15 minutes (walking) distance from eachother . At the visitors centre there are free white bicycles available for everybody.



- 13.00 hr Departure by bus from conference venue Hof van Wageningen,lunchpackages and drinks will be provided in the hall of the conference venue
- 14.00 hr Bus 1: Arrival at the Kröller-Muller Museum for those who want to start with the museum. Introduction and guided tour in the museum and sculpture garden. Afterwards follow the signs to the visitor centre.
- 14.15 hr Bus 2: Arrival at the Visitors centre /MuseOnder / shop / restaurant / bicylcles.

Bicycle tour through the park guided by a ranger .

- 16.45 hr Departure by bus from the Visitors centre to Hof van Wageningen.
- 17.45 hr Arrival at the Hof van Wageningen
- 18.45 hr Departure by bus to the conference dinner
